

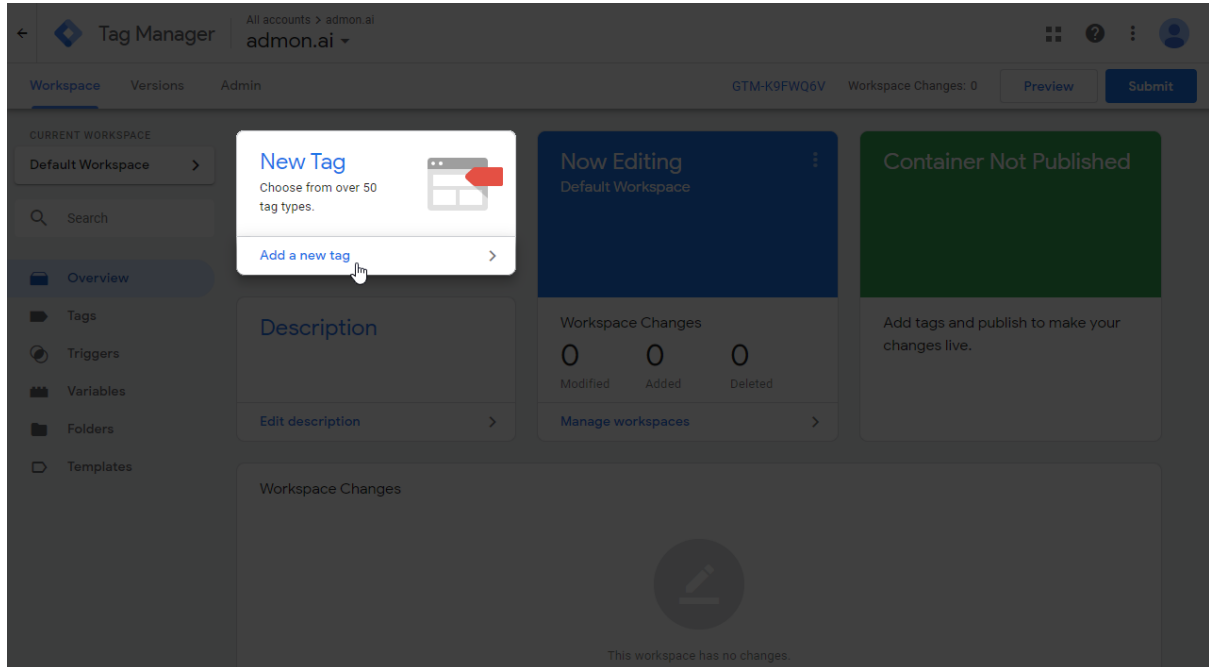

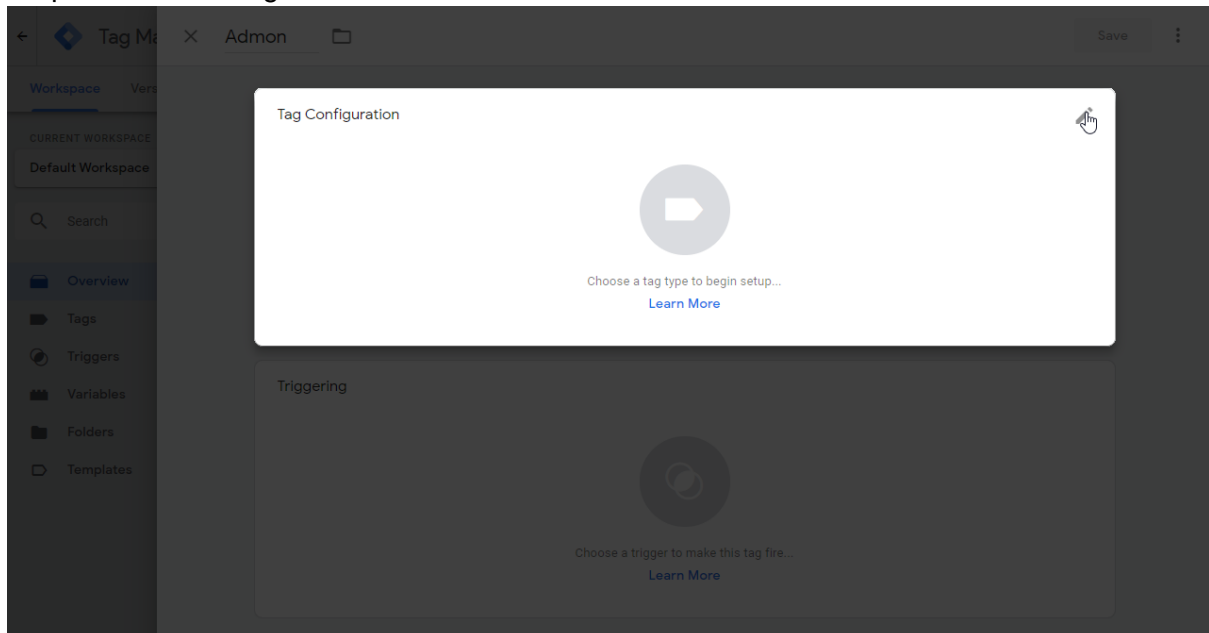

Add this script as Custom HTML

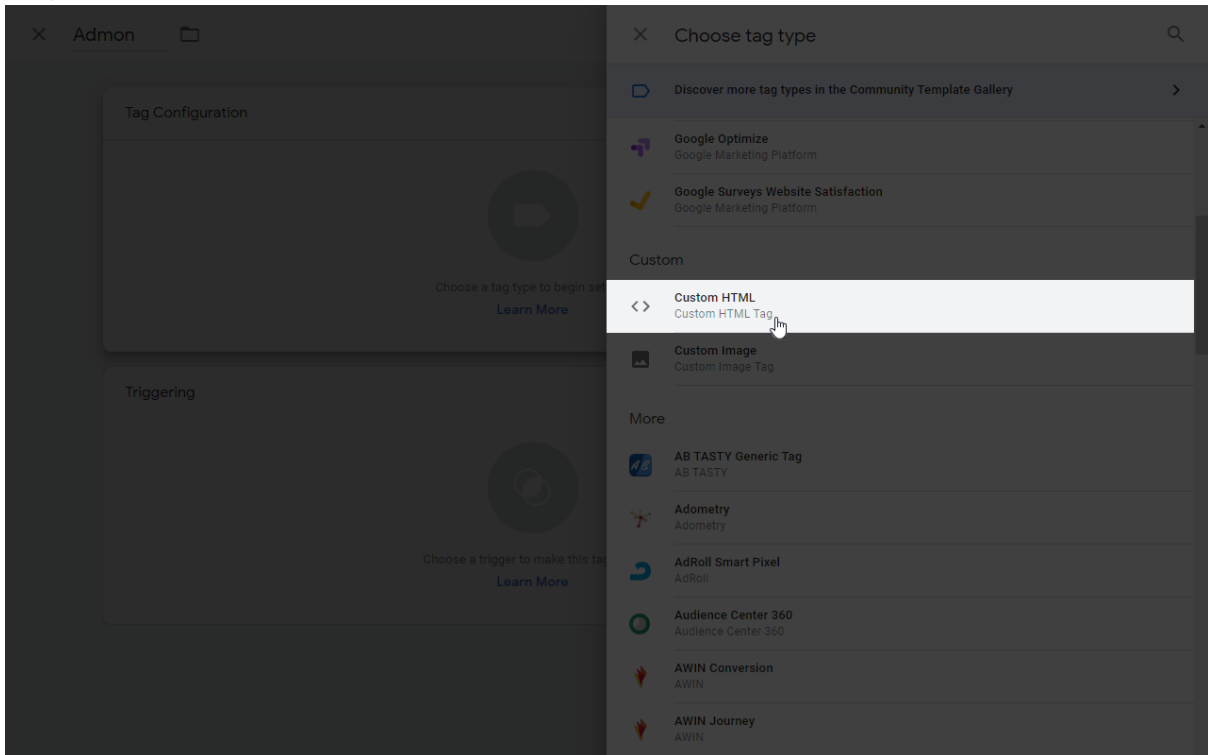
Step 1. Click ADD A NEW TAG



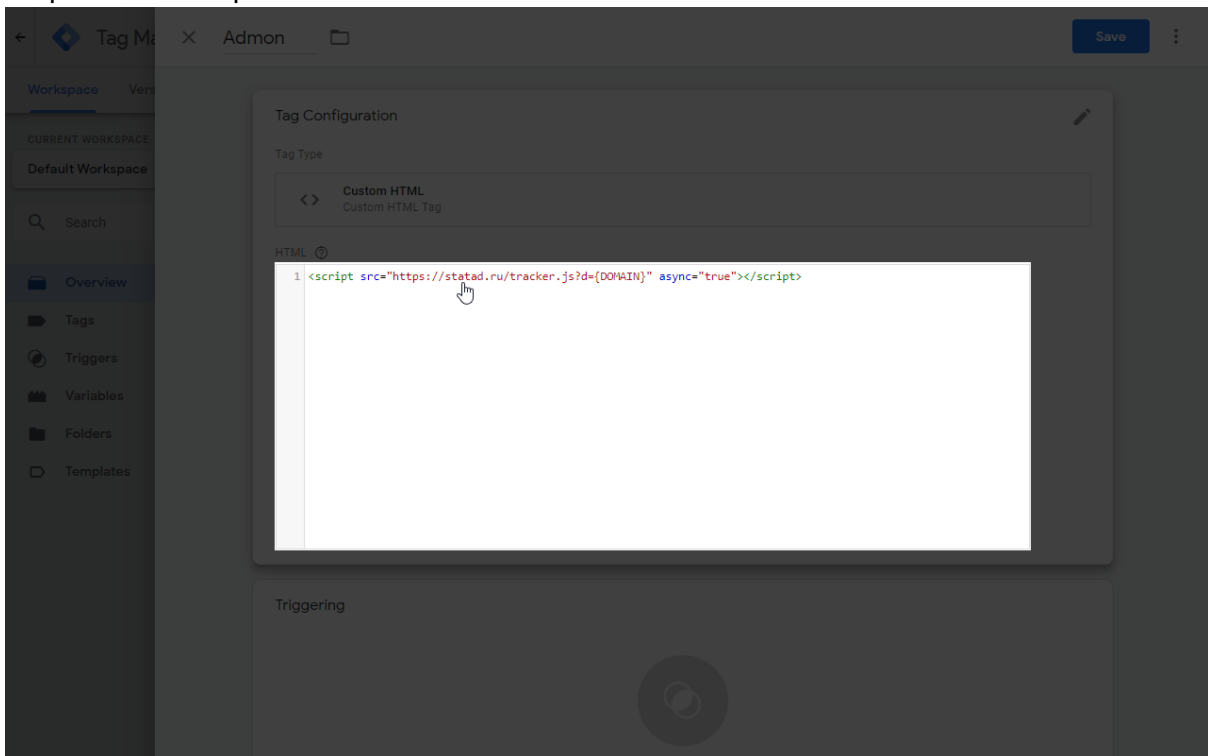
Step 2. Click Edit tag button



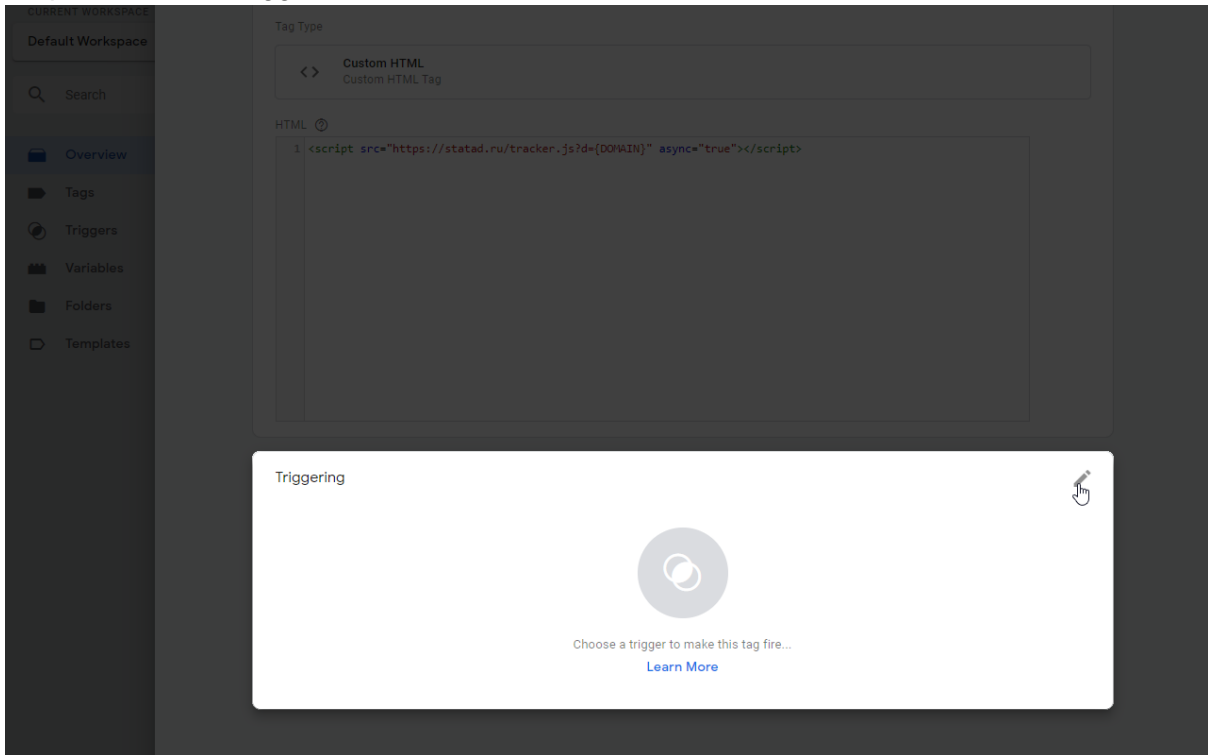
Step 3. Select Custom HTML



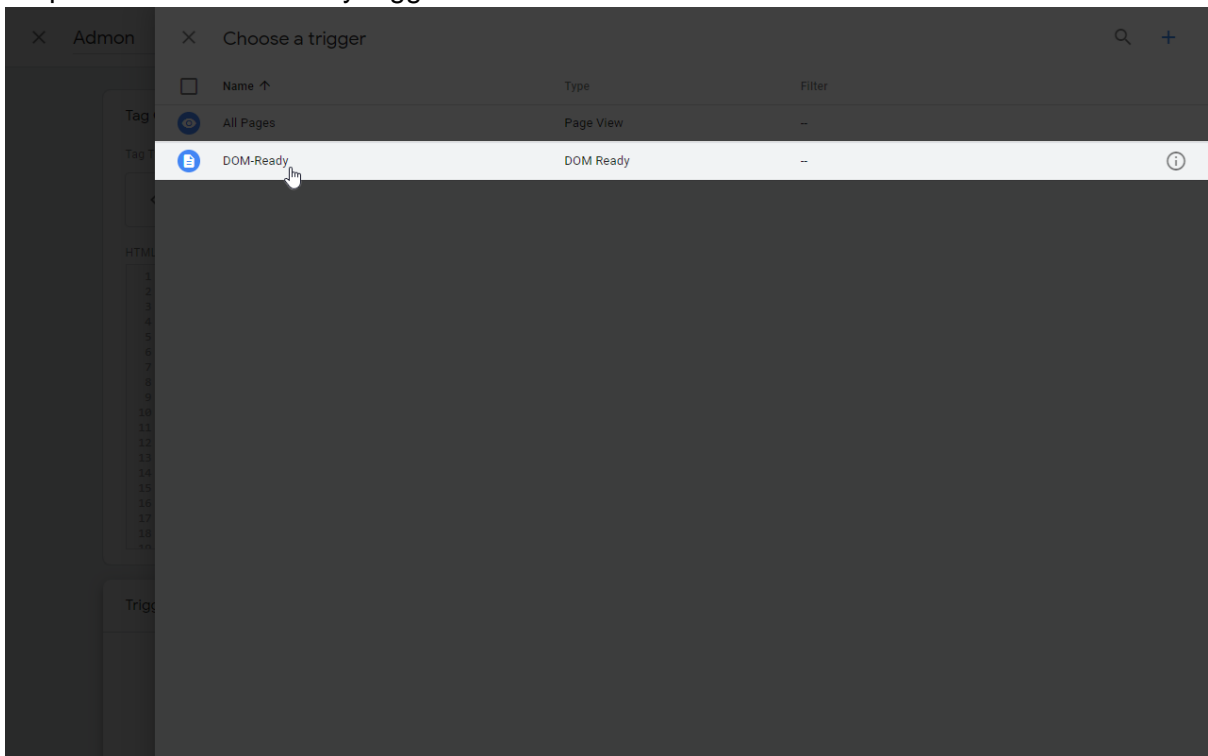
Step 4. Insert script



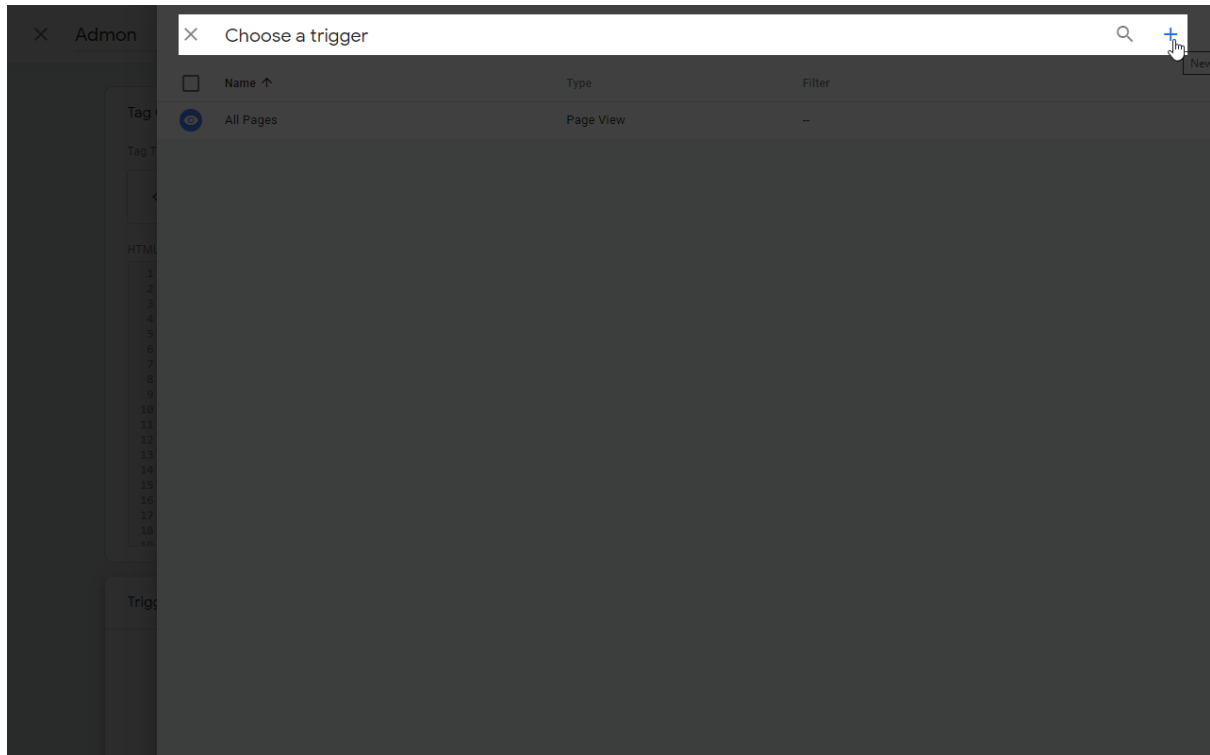
Step 5. Click Edit trigger button



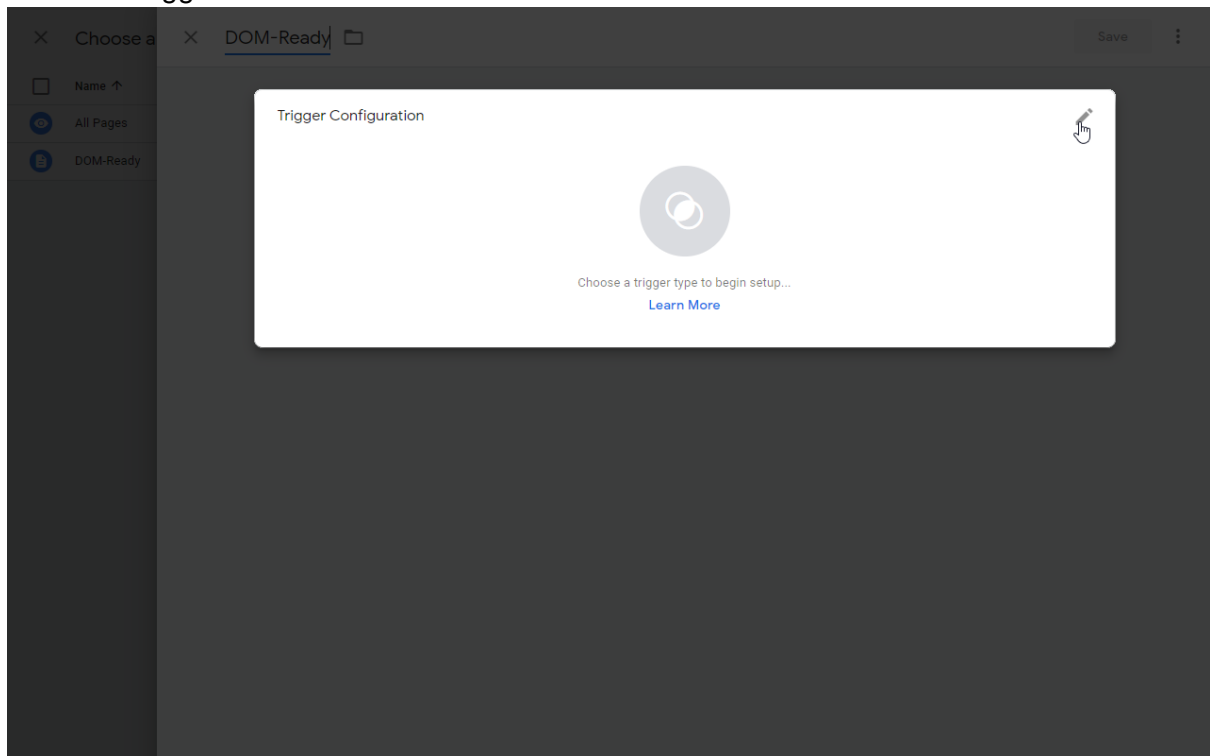
Step 6. Select DOM Ready trigger if available



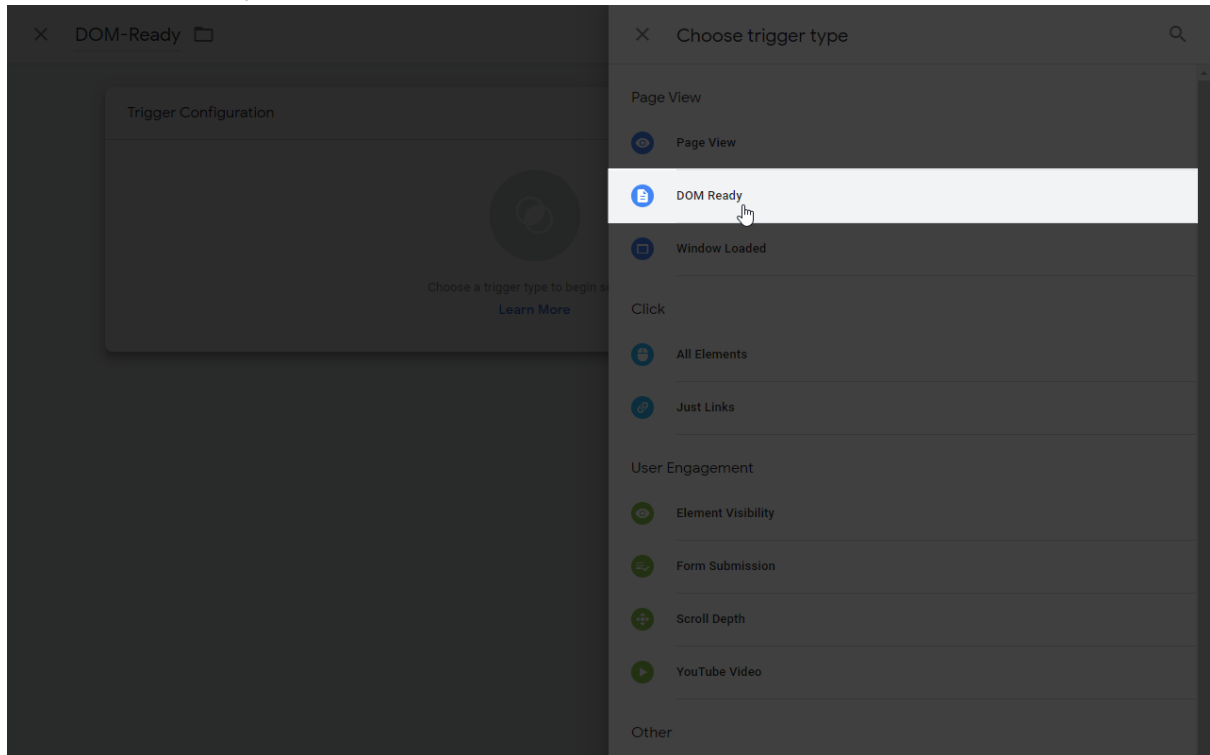
If it is not available - click Add button



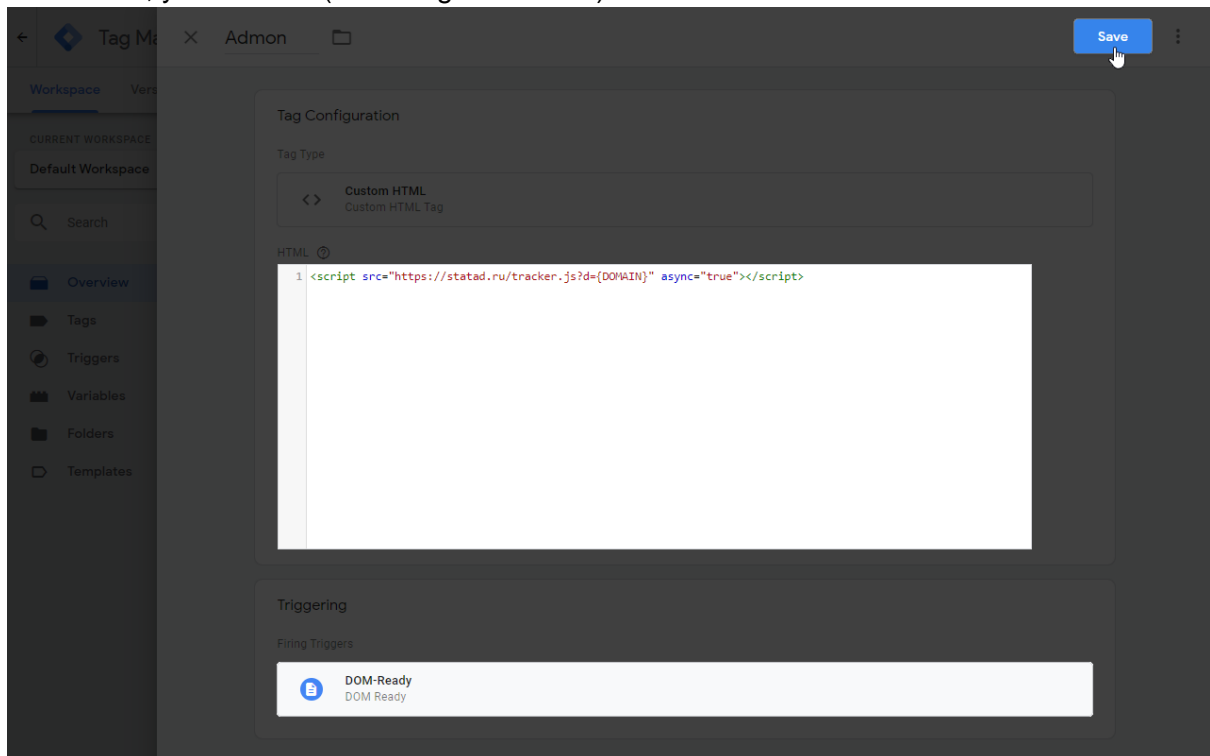
Click Edit trigger button
