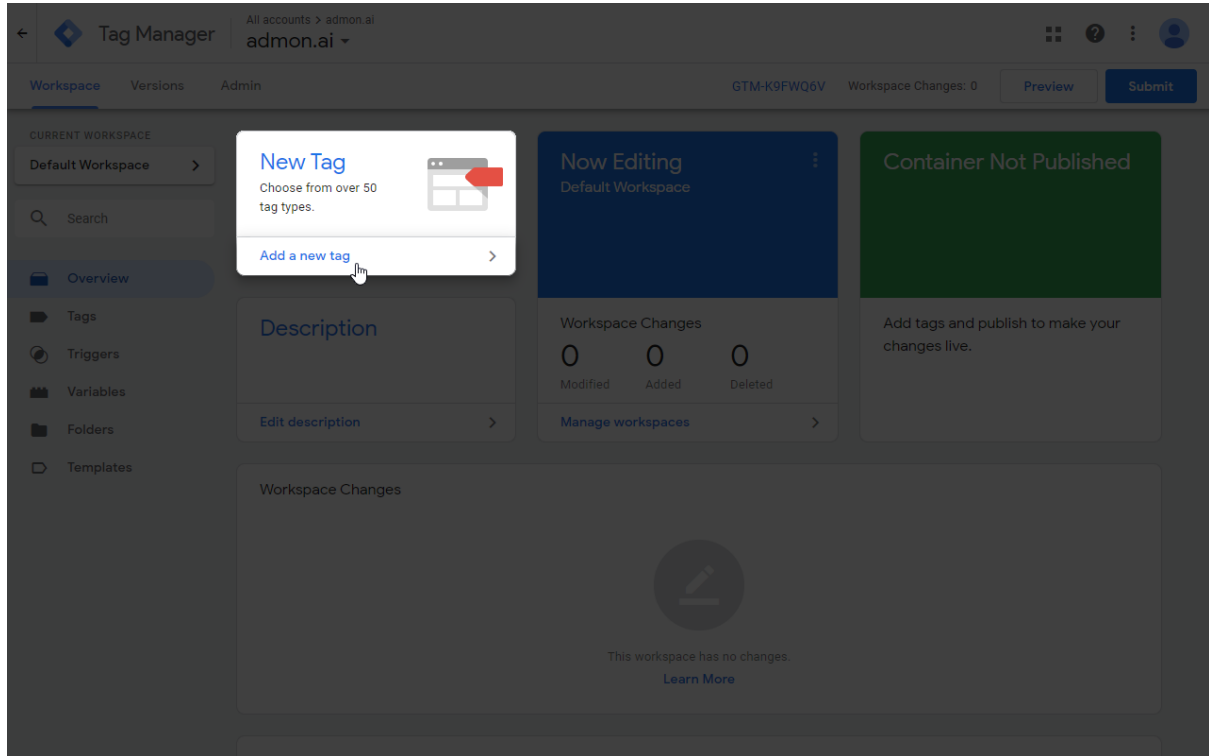
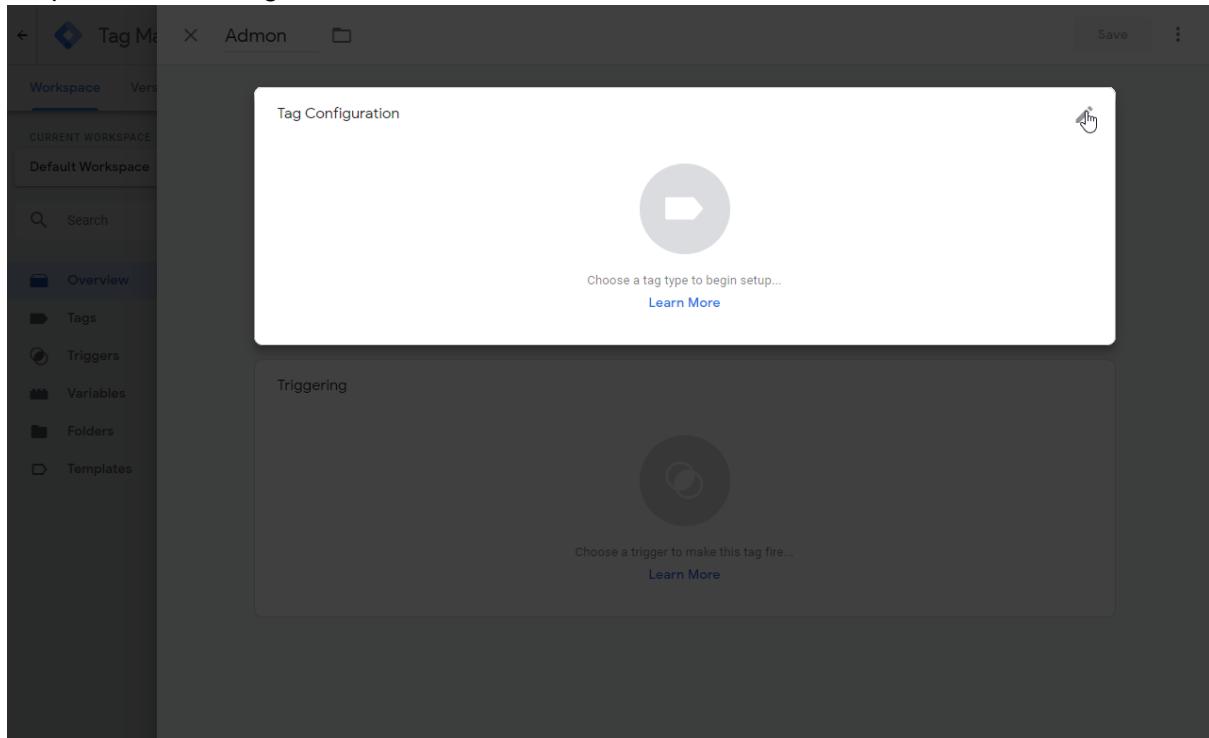

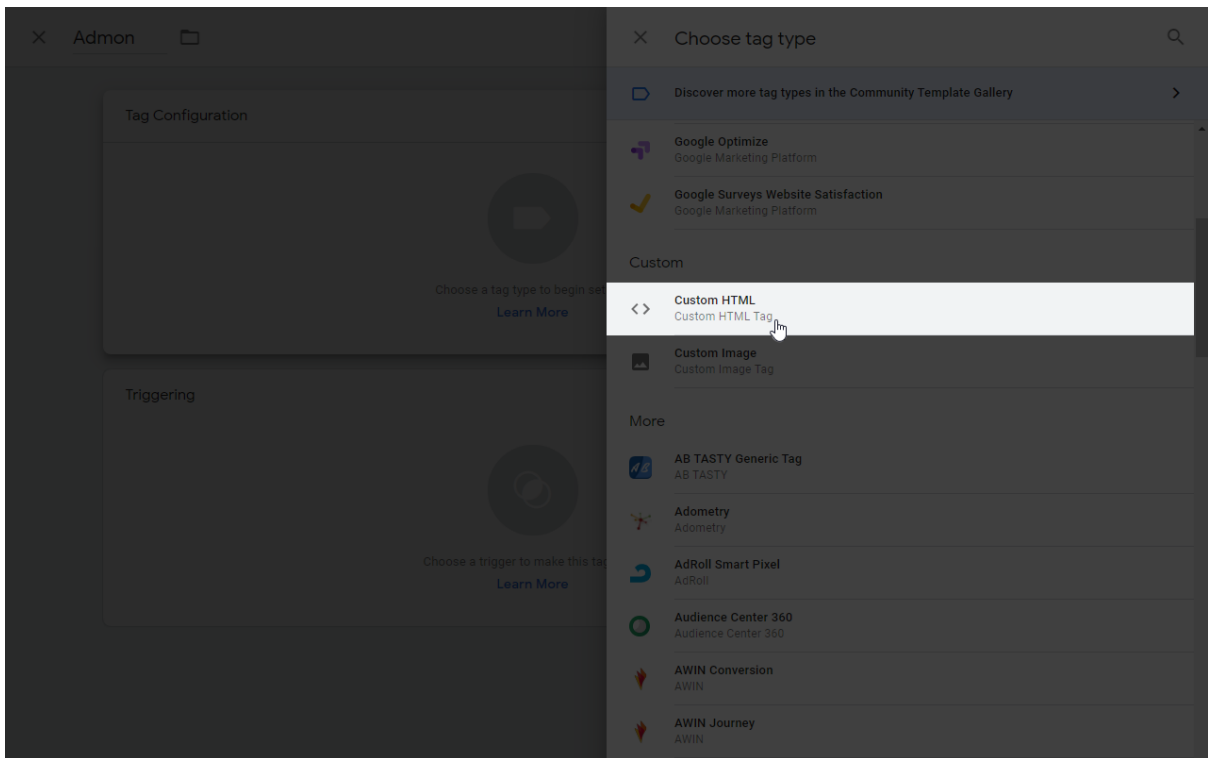
### Step 1. Click ADD A NEW TAG



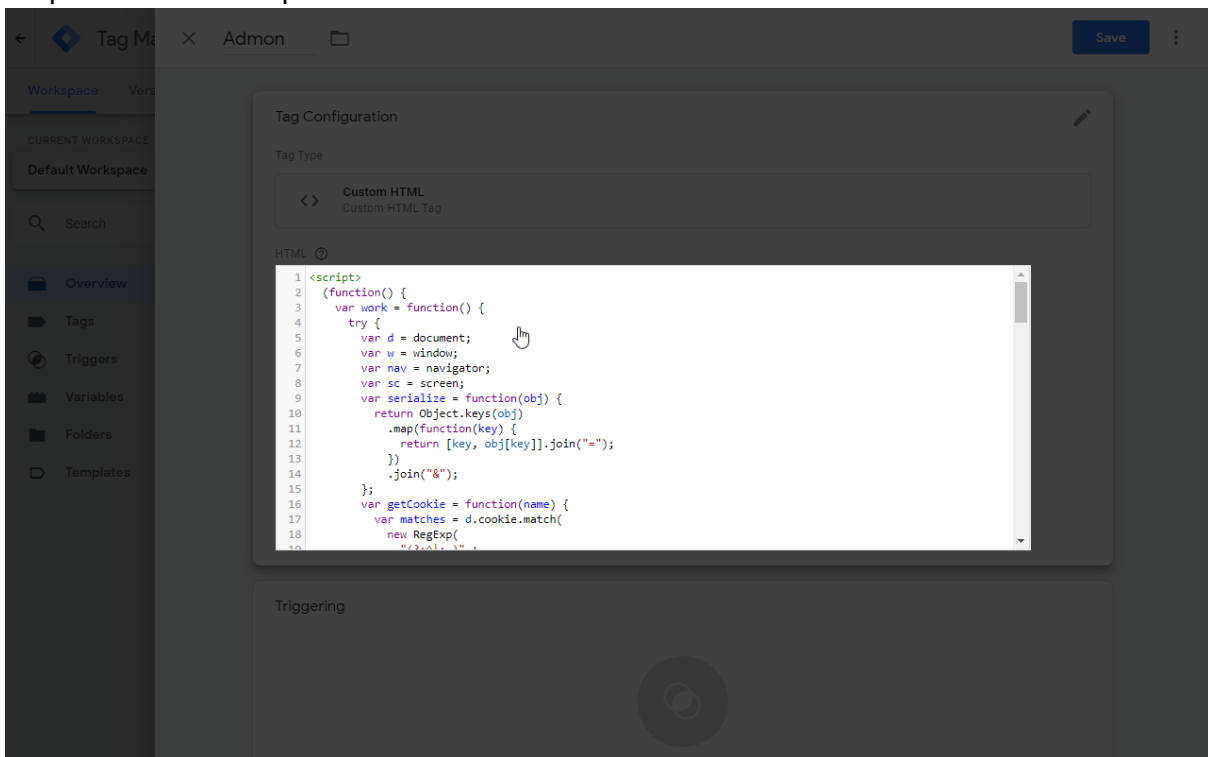
### Step 2. Click Edit tag button



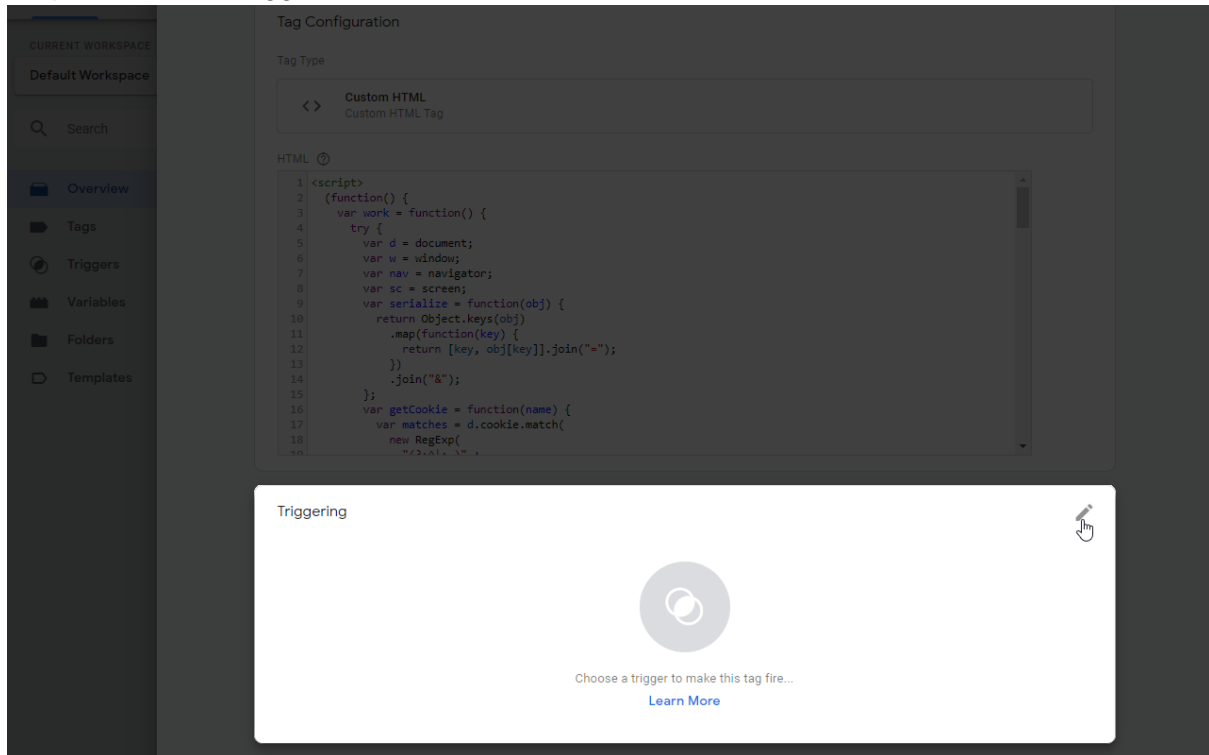
### Step 3. Select Custom HTML



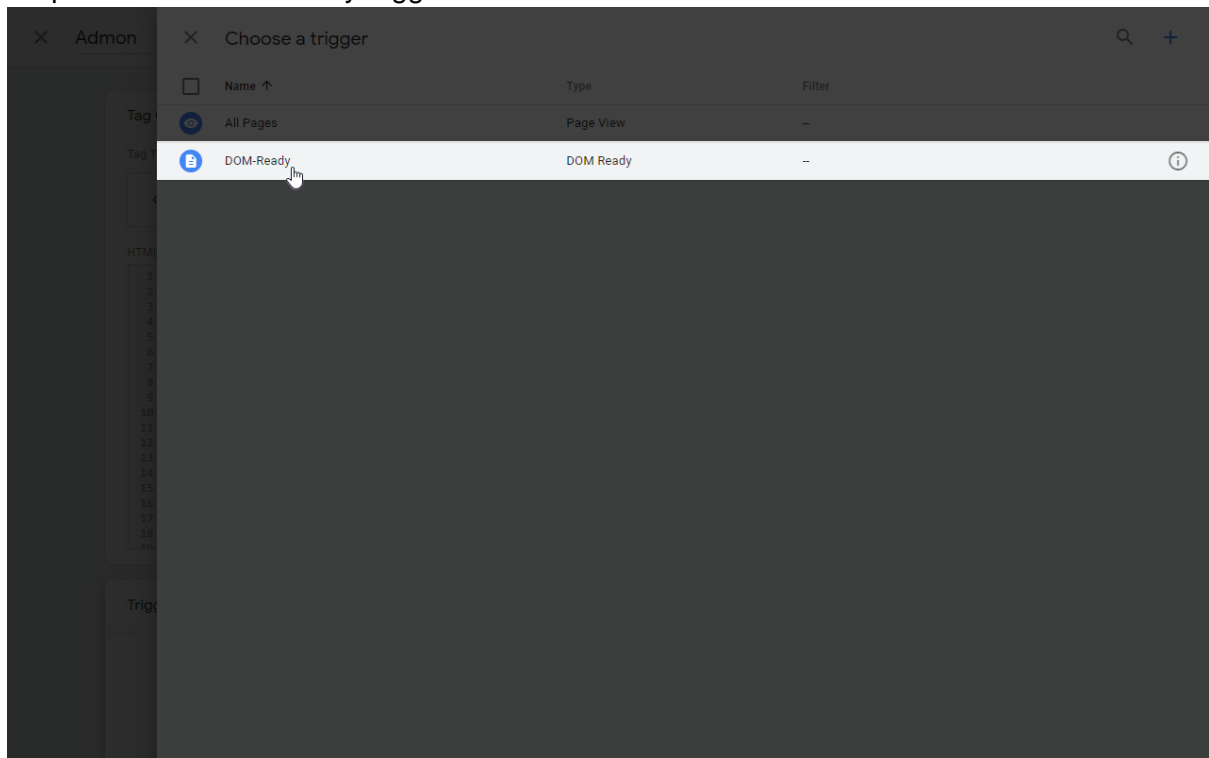
#### Step 4. Insert the script



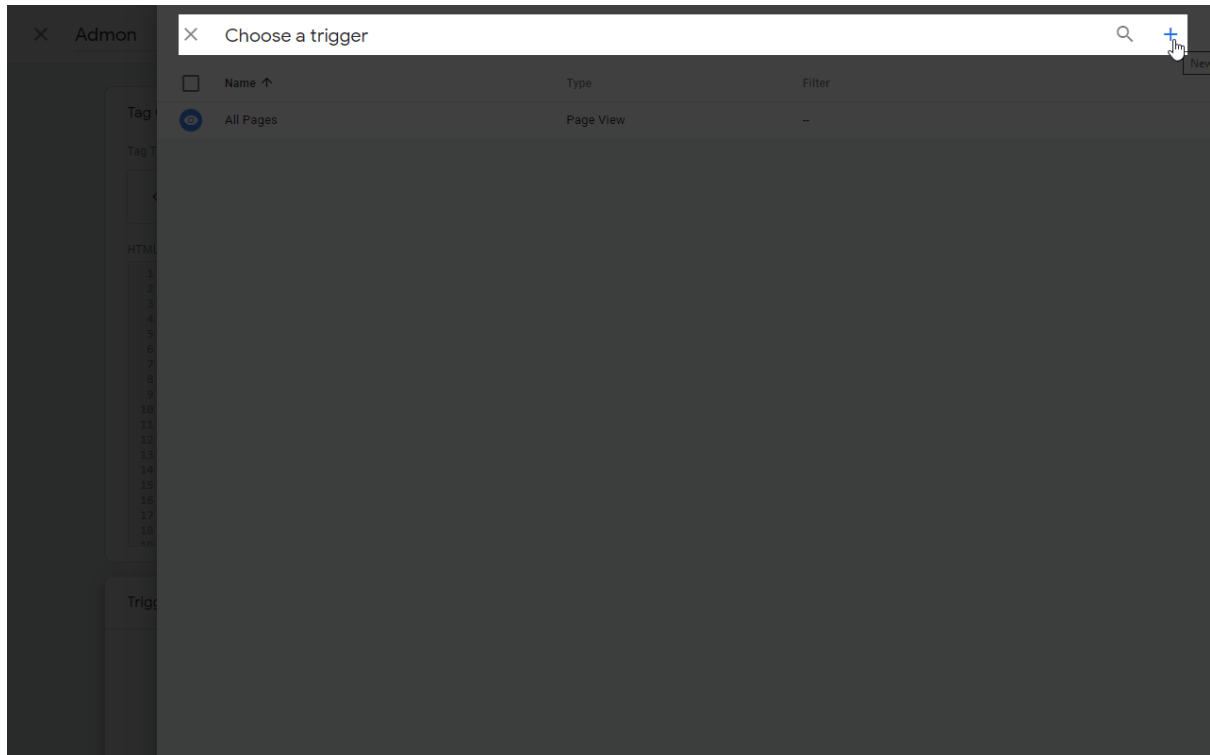
## Step 5. Click Edit trigger button



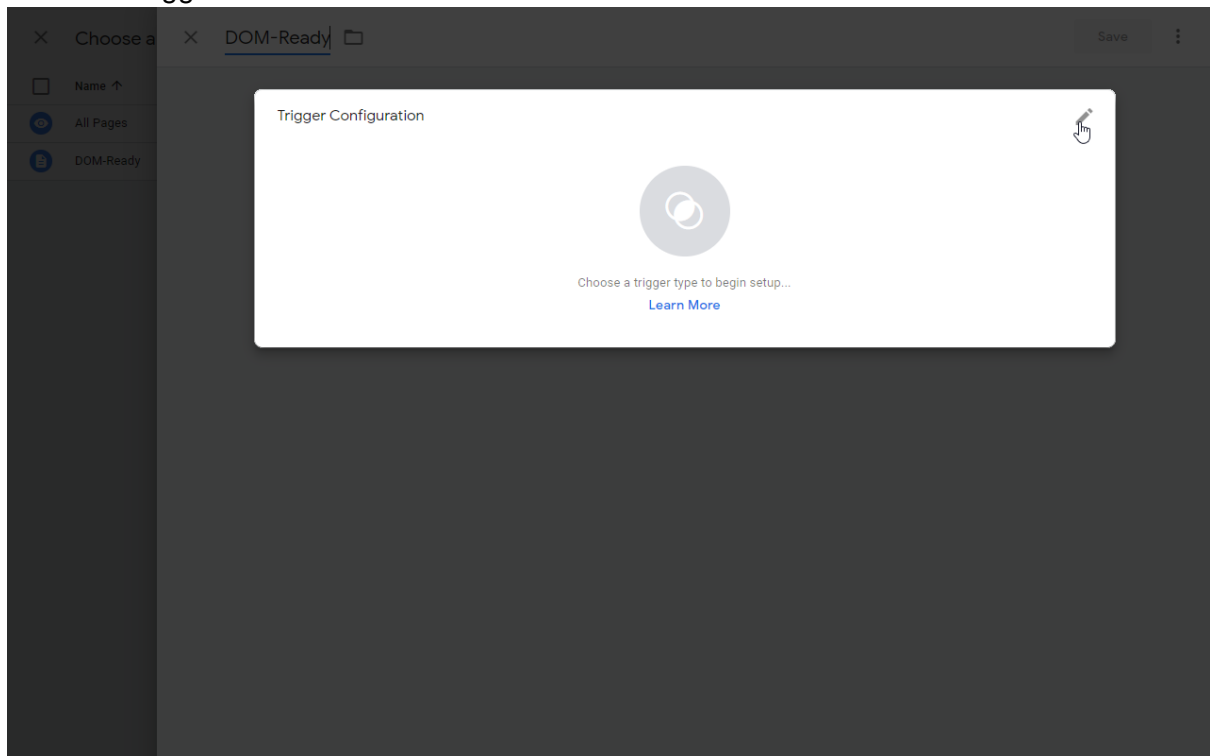
## Step 6. Select DOM Ready trigger if available



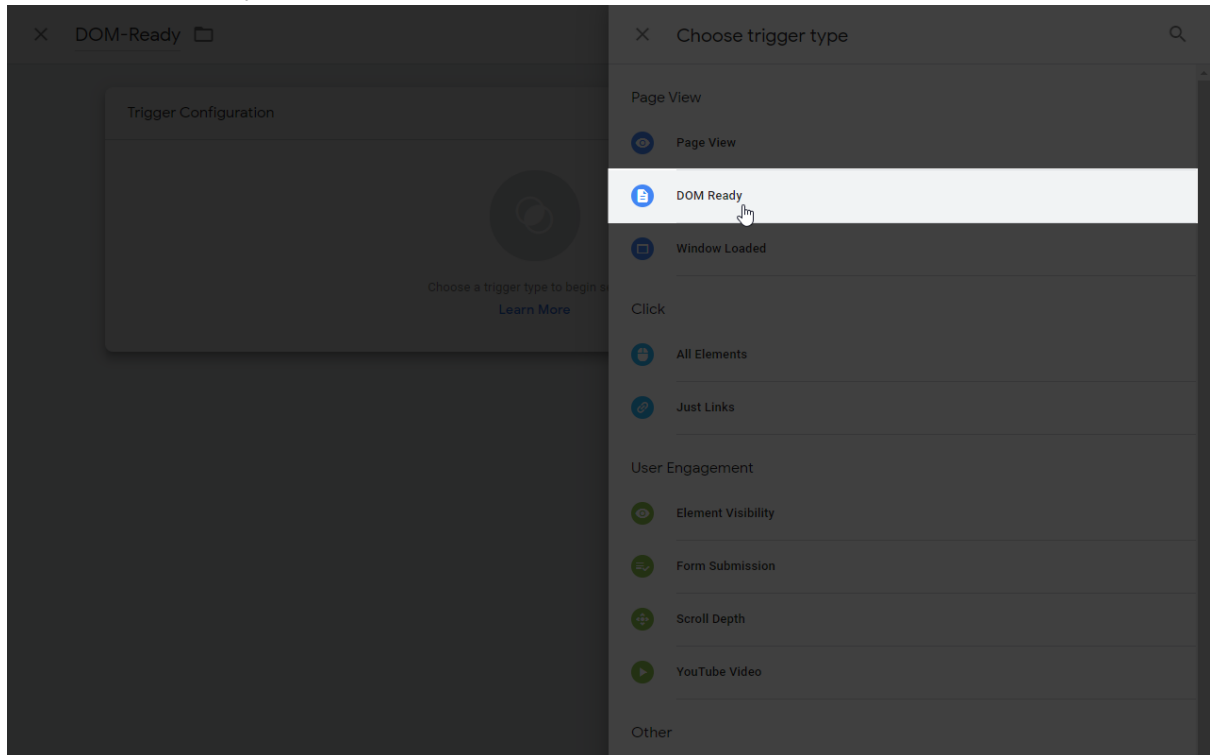

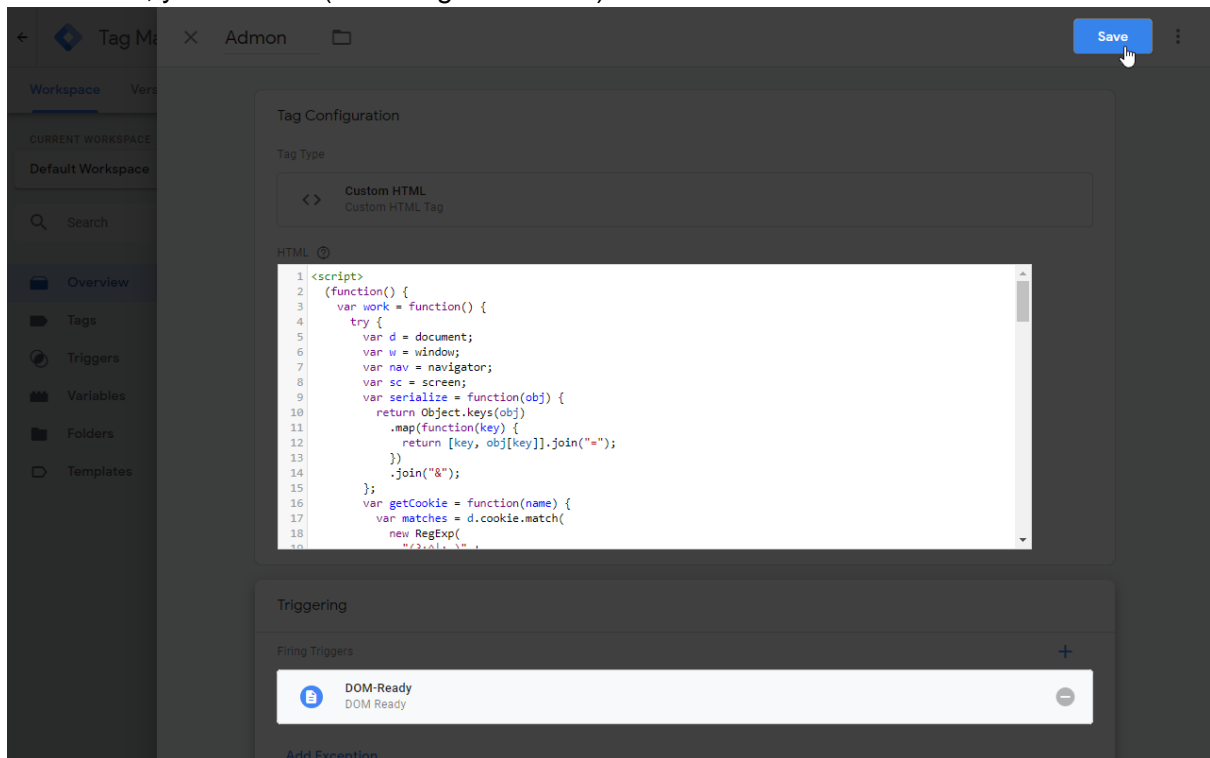
